**Auckland** - New Zealand's biggest city, also known as the City of Sails is famous for its fabulous restaurants, bars and cafés. The harbour offers not only amazing views, but is also a starting point to travel to Hauraki Gulf islands.



#### Waikato / Waitomo -

National Park/Ohakune -

**Kaikōura** - the picturesque coastal town of Kaikōura is the perfect place for coastal walks, marine life and tucking into a plate of crayfish. A truly special experience in the region is marine mammal encounters – whales, fur seals and dolphins live permanently in the coastal waters.



**Christchurch** - the South Island's largest city, combining urban regeneration and innovation with heritage, culture and exhilarating activity. Think street art and innovative projects, a bustling hospitality scene and established green spaces.





# FAQ

#### Q. Can airport departure transfer be arranged?

A. Absolutely, we are able to arrange transfer for various group sizes from domestic or international terminals.

#### Q. Are meals included?

A. Inclusions vary depending on the tour/package chosen, with various breakfast, lunch and dinner options available.

#### Q. Do you cater for any dietary requirements?

A. Dietary requirements can be catered for, advise team 7 days prior to departure.

#### Q. Is travel insurance included in the tour/package?

A. It is not included, but we strongly recommend that all travellers have a policy that also covers personal liability, medical, cancellation, curtailment and loss of luggage or personal effects.

# Q. What time are we required to meet the group each morning?

A. Each tour/itinerary will vary depending on the daily activities. The tour director will provide this info day by day.

#### Q. Can you assist with any visa enquires?

A. Unfortunately, we cannot assist with any visa enquires.

#### Q. What should the guests bring on tour?

- A. On your journey, you may bring 1x 23kg checked bag, 1x cabin luggage less than 7kg as well as a small handbag. We highly recommend packing a small bag or handbag filled with essentials to take aboard the trains. Suitcases will be securely stored in the dedicated luggage carriage onboard the trains.
  - ✓ Credit/debit card or cash (for anything additional you wish to purchase in the Scenic Café)
  - ✓ A jacket (for the open-air viewing carriage)
  - Mobile phone (selected seats have USB ports for charging devices)
  - 🗸 Camera
  - ✓ Sunglasses
  - ✓ Medication/inhaler

#### Q. Will there be any free time?

A. There will be free time on each tour, but will vary depending on the itinerary

# Q. Is there a minimum or maximum number of guests custom group tours can be booked for?

A. We are happy to accommodate any number of guests on custom tours, there is no minimum or maximum number.

#### Q. Do I need to check in my luggage?

A. All wheeled cabin bags, large bags, backpacks and suitcases will be checked into our Luggage Carriage. Please pack a small bag with everything you'll need for the day. To check in your luggage, simply attach luggage labels to your bags, drop them off at the Luggage Carriage, retain the label stub for reference, and collect your bags from the Carriage at your destination.

#### Q. What is the baggeage allowance?

A. Luggage allowances for Scenic Class and Scenic Plus passengers include: 1 large checked bag, 1 cabin bag, 1 small bag or handbag, and 1 small infant bag (if applicable). Scenic Plus passengers have an additional large checked bag allowance. All bags have specific weight and volume restrictions.

#### Q. Can I come if I'm vision impaired?

A. If you are visually impaired and need assistance, then our staff are trained and happy to help you get on board and enjoy the journey.

#### Q. Can I come if I'm hearing impaired?

A. All our scenic train carriages are fitted with hearing loops. To activate your built-in transformer, select the 'T' switch on the hearing aid. The hearing loop will boost the PA sound levels within the carriages.

#### Q. How much walking is required?

A. As long as you're comfortable walking for up to 15 minutes, you should be well-prepared for our tours.

#### Q. What is the standard of accommodation?

A. Depending on a tour, accomodation varies between 3.5 star to 5 star hotels.

#### Q. Do I have to pay more if I want a room to myself?

A. All our tour bookings are based on shared twin accommodation. If you prefer a private room, a single supplement will apply..

#### Q. Can you book pre or post tour accommodation for me?

A. Please talk to our helpful team directly about booking pre or post-accommodation. Just reach out to our team via travelcentre@greatjourneysnz.com.

#### Q. Are arrival and departure transfers included on tour?

A. Arrival transfer is not included in the tour, but can be booked at an additional cost. Departure transfer is included in Signature tours only.

#### Q. What time should I arrive on the first day of tour?

A. We recommend arriving in the afternoon of the first day of your tour, giving you time to relax before meeting the group for dinner.
